



Tactical Room Clearing for the Patrol Officer

DESCRIPTION: Working doors and entering rooms is one of the most common yet challenging tasks law enforcement officers "on the front line" conduct every day in the performance of their duties. Students will learn two, three, and four person team room entry techniques while engaging single threats and multiple threats during shoot / no-shoot decision making drills.

- Presenting from ready pistol.
- Team movements.
- Threat assessment and area scanning.
- Dominating the weapon, threat and visual areas.
- Basic elements of dynamic room entry.
- Slicing the pie and limited penetration.
- Quick peek techniques.
- Hand signals and silent communication.

- Establishing interlocking fields of fire.
- Cross over room entry.
- Buttonhook room entry.
- Crises cross team room entry.
- Two man stack - team room entry.
- Shooting on the move.
