Preparing First Responders for the Active Shooter A Two-Day Course

TOPICS: Day 1 - Historical Overview of Active Shooter Situations, Law

Enforcement Response to an Active Shooter, Contact and Rescue Team Response, Barricade and Hostage Incident Resolution Tactics, Basic Movement Techniques, Breeching Techniques, and Incident

Command Response.

Day 2 - Practical Exercises

ASSUMPTION: Participants are certified law enforcement officers. Training will be

conducted at a facility provided by the requesting agency. A classroom suitable for class size with media capabilities is

necessary.

EVALUATION: Participants must demonstrate mastery of the subject matter

through successful completion of practical exercises and a written

final exam.
